- i. History (HL/SL)
- ii. Geography (HL/SL)
- iii. Economics (HL/SL)
- iv. Business and Management (HL/SL)
- v. Psychology (HL/SL)

Group 4 : Experimental Sciences

- i. Physics (HL/SL)
- ii. Chemistry (HL/SL)
- iii. Biology (HL/SL)
- iv. Environmental Systems and Society (SL)

Group 5 : Mathematics and Computer Science

- i. Mathematics Higher (HL)
- ii. Mathematics Methods (SL)
- iii. Mathematics Studies (SL)
- iv. Computer Science (HL/SL)

Group 6 : The Arts

- i. Theatre Studies (HL/SL)
- ii. Visual Arts (HL/SL)
