Diploma students would be required to select **ONE** subject from each of the six subject groups, which correspond to the principal domains of knowledge. At least three and not more than four are taken at higher level (HL) and others at standard level (SL). The subject groups are:

Group 1 -Language A1

- i. English (HL/SL) and Self taught languages
- ii. Hindi (HL/SL)

Group 2 -Second Language

- i. Language B – French (HL/SL)
- ii. Language B – German (SL)
- iii. Language B - English (HL/SL)
- iv. Language ab initio –Spanish (SL)
- v. Language B - Spanish (SL)

Group 3 -Individuals and Societies

- i. History (HL/SL)
- ii. Geography (HL/SL)
- iii. Economics (HL/SL)
- iv. Business and Management (HL/SL)
- v. Psychology (HL/SL)

Group 4 -Experimental Sciences

- i. Physics (HL/SL)
- ii. Chemistry (HL/SL)
- iii. Biology (HL/SL)
- iv. Eco Systems and Societies (SL)

Group 5 -Mathematics and Computer Science

- i. Math Higher (HL)
- ii. Math Standard (SL)
- iii. Math Studies (SL)
- iv. Computer Science (HL/SL)

Group 6 -The Arts

- i. Theatre Studies (HL/SL)
- ii. Visual Art (HL/SL)
- iii. Music (HL/SL)

Notes:

- Biology and Eco Sysytems and Societies may not be taken together.
- English must be taken as either A1 or as English B.
- Computer Sciences and Maths can be taken together but 2 Maths cannot be taken together.
- Only 1 Arts (Theatre, Music or Visual Art) can be taken .
- Permission is required from IBO to do 3 sciences.
