### IBDP results 2015

- One of our students achieved the perfect score of 45.
- 23% of our students achieved 40+ points, with two scoring 44 each, recording an 8% increase over 2014.
- 56% achieved 35+ points, a 6% increase compared to 2014.
- 77% achieved 30+ points.
- School average of two bonus points for Theory of Knowledge and Extended Essay.
- 35 out of 37 courses scored above world averages.
- Average 36 points - a remarkable 2 point increase compared to 2014!

### IGCSE/GCSE results 2014

Of a total 474 subject entries:

- 55% of the cohort achieved A\*-A grades of which 31% achieved an A\*.
- 90% students achieved 5 A\* to C grades.
- A\*-B grades accounted for 77% of the total entries.
- Three students achieved all A\* grades.
- 17 students of the 2014 cohort achieved a minimum of 7 A\*-A grades with no grade below a B.
- For the second year in succession our students have received a number of Cambridge Young Learners' Awards recognising excellent achievement in India and the world.

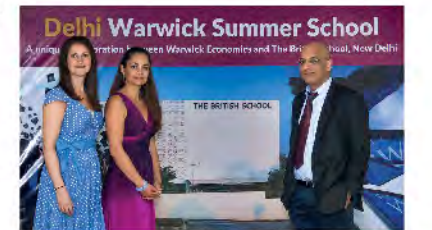
### Primary School:

- The British School is the leading provider of an accredited Early Years Foundation Stage provision in India, offering an outstanding curriculum which is highly rated by external experts.
- Pilot project trialing 1-1 use of iPads and Apple TVs' in the Upper Primary; focus on developing IT skills across all key stages.
- 'Eco-warrior drive' to sensitise students towards the environment.
- Student-led curriculum workshops for parents showcasing the delivery of the 'linked learning' curriculum.
- Robotics club launched for students of Years 4 - 6.



## Thought leadership

- Strong leadership - Ms Vanita Uppal became the first serving Indian Principal to be awarded the OBE (Order of the British Empire) by H M Queen Elizabeth II, for services to British style education.
- Sharing best practice – Our staff led a full day training for teachers from local and international schools on 'Gifted & Talented Provision'. Another 30% of The British School staff was trained by in-house master trainers.
- The IB department led a full day training on 'Theory of Knowledge' and the 'Language and Literature' course for teachers from other IB schools.
- One third of our IB teachers are IB examiners/workshop leaders/syllabus developers.
- Our school pioneered an innovative mentorship programme for the introduction of IGCSE with the Sanskaar Valley School, Bhopal which has been highly acclaimed by CIE (Cambridge International Examinations).
- We are the first school in India to become a Common Sense Digital Citizenship certified school.
- The school partnered with CEOP (Child Exploitation and Online Protection Centre) and the British Council, New Delhi to host the first two-day training in 'Child protection against online abuse' for carers and teachers.
- For the first time in India, the University of Warwick collaborated with The British School, to run their Economics and Finance Summer School which was a tremendous success.



## Membership

The British School became the first and only school in India to be awarded membership of FOBISIA (The Federation of British International Schools in Asia).



## Community Outreach

- Completion of a two-year programme in collaboration with INTACH (Indian National Trust for Arts and Cultural Heritage) to train teachers from Jammu & Kashmir in the delivery of an arts integrated inter-disciplinary programme through which 100 master trainers have been trained, impacting 5000 students.
- Ice Bucket Challenge, a whole school initiative which raised Rs 2.5 lakhs for flood victims of J & K.
- Two tonnes of supplies and cash donations for Nepal earthquake victims.
- Ongoing service projects involving both primary and secondary students with under privileged and physically challenged children, at old age homes and providing support for cancer survivors.

## Enrichment programme

- We hosted our fourth ISTA (International Schools Theatrical Arts) conference for 14-16 year olds.

## Infrastructure

- Dedicated EYFS space with safety play surfaces, a splash pool, an amphitheatre and a sand pit for outdoor activities and learning.
- Spacious libraries with plenty of natural light spread over three floors.
- An air-conditioned cafeteria.
- A state-of-the-art multipurpose air-conditioned indoor sports complex with a well-equipped mini gym.
- Purpose built IB Centre.
- Modern, well-equipped science laboratories.
- Health Room with trained nursing staff.
- Play grounds for outdoor sports.
- Wi-Fi enabled campus.
